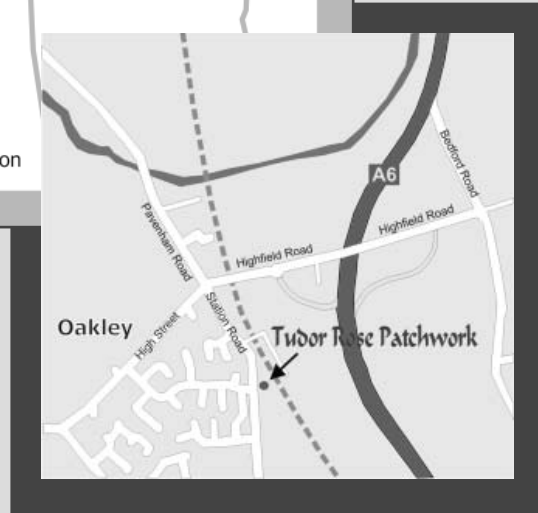
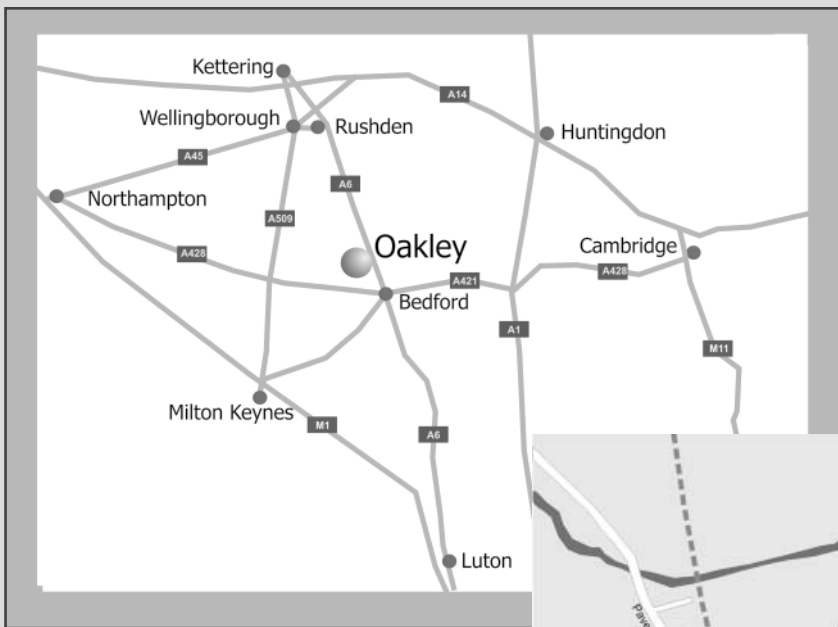

Hand Sewn Fabric Covered Books

Saturday, July 16, 2011 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Book-binding is an ancient and skilled craft, with many historic variations in design, style and construction. The oldest "books" were in the form of scrolls, but gradually, people developed techniques to make their parchment and paper sheets into books, stitched together and protected by boards or covers.

This workshop will show you how to combine some traditional book-binding techniques, with a modern method of making paper-backed book-cloth, to create your own fabric-covered notebooks, journals, scrapbooks or photo albums. We will make basic pamphlet-style, hand-stitched pocket notebooks, with decorative ribbon ties. We'll then move on to learn an ancient Oriental stab-stitch, which we'll use to create an attractive little sketchbook or album. The books will have fabric covers, made from your own book-cloth; all the techniques you learn can be used to make more books at home, for your own use, or as useful and attractive hand-made gifts.
